Aidenvironment develops Realtime Deforestation Monitoring (RDM) reports to engage companies and urge action towards real-time deforestation events, as well as to support financial sector and civil society stakeholders in their efforts to halt deforestation linked to commodity production and trade. In Brazil, recent increase of deforestation rates is mostly linked to the expansion of Soy and Cattle production within Amazon and Cerrado biomes. The RDM report of April 2022 presents eight cases linking recent deforestation to soy traders' and beef processors' supply chains. Four cases are in Amazon biome and four in Cerrado biome. The total deforestation reported by the eight cases is 13,930 hectares, which are linked to 229 fire alerts.

José Carlos Pires Carneiro is linked to companies responsible for "colonization" processes in the central-western part of the country during the Brazilian military dictatorship (1964-1985), being one of the owners of Tapiraguaia Agrícola e Pecuária (1). Frenova is linked with a "colonization" company in Confresa, needs more investigation to understand whether they are still present in the properties or if they were recently sold to someone else (2). Frenova is one of the companies that contested the demarcation of Terra Indígena Urubu Branco in Goiás, Tocantins and Maranhão - needs more investigation to confirm that this is the same company (3). In the 1980s, indigenous organisations denounced the invasion of indigenous lands – currently Terra Indígena Urubu Branco – of the Tupinaré people José Carlos Pires Carneiro, owner of the Tapiraguaia Farm in the northeast of the state of Mato Grosso (4).

The Global Witness has investigated the business of the Piana Capello family in western Bahia (1). Suzana Piana Capello is part of a group of seven farmers who have been jointly litigating against eight community members of the traditional "fecho de pasto" community of Capão do Modesto, in Correntina (BA). The alleged owners accuse the community members of trespassing on their legal reserves (protected by the Forest Code) and causing material damage. The Fazenda Serrana IV, one of Piana Capello Agropecuária's properties in Correntina (BA), also overlaps with "fecho de pasto" community of Porcos, Guará and Pombas, which traditionally occupy this Cerrado territory. Suzane Mari Piana is also director and shareholder of Ciaseeds Agronegócios, a major soybean and cotton seed supplier with offices in four cities of Matopiba.





The Diamante, Esmeralda, and Safira farms, located in Baixa Grande do Ribeiro and Santa Filomena, are soybean and corn producers and supply grain to traders Bunge and Cargill (1). They also claim to own 35.384 thousand hectares distributed in the states of São Paulo, Goiás and Piauí producing soy, corn, sugar cane, beans and cattle. In 2013 and 2014 Damha Agronegócios received loans from BNDES agricultural credit lines granted by Banco do Brasil and Banco Pine (2). The company's farm Fazenda Bonança, in Pereira Barreto (SP), is authorized to export fresh beef to the EU (3).

General comments

Serra Branca Agrícola is a project of Grupo Tomazini, Nutriza/Friato for integrated operations in Uruçuí, Piauí (1). The agro-industrial complex is composed of corn and soy production, feeding industry, warehouses and poultry slaughterhouses. Nutriza/Friato has 30,000 hectares of soy plantations and 20,000 hectares of corn plantations (2). These plantations are used for feeding 35,000 animals in 500 aviary farms (3). Nutriza/Friato poultry production is exported to Asia, Africa, Middle East and Russia (4). Grupo Tomazini is associated with an illegal land grabbing (grilagem) of BRL 80 million in 2017, when Terra Imóveis owned by the land grabber João Batista Fernandes - known as JB - bought the land for a paltry price and shortly afterwards sold it to the Tomazini Group for BRL 80 million (5). There is also an active lawsuit against Serra Branca Agrícola filed by José Maria Martins de Sousa, in which he declares that an inherited farm from his parents was illegally occupied by Serra Branca Agrícola crop plantations (6). Tomazini family, from Ipuã in São Paulo, started investing in farmlands in the 1980s through the company Agropecuária Ipuã. The family expanded its operations through Nutriza/Friato Alimentos in Pires do Rio (GO), Fazenda Santa Maria in Caldas Novas (GO), Armazéns Gerais Ipuã in Ipameri (GO) and Serra Branca Agrícola in Uruçuí (PI). In 2016, the group announced an investment of BRL 1 billion in its operations in Piauí, which included the establishment of a chicken slaughterhouse plant in partnership with Mitsubishi (7) (8), apparently not yet completed. From 1995-1999, Francisco Roberto Tomazini, the CEO of Grupo Tomazini, was state deputy in Goiás (9). His wife, Cida Tomazini was mayor for three mandates of Pires do Rio, where Friato Alimentos is headquartered, and recently launched her candidacy for 2020 municipal elections, trying to be elected for the fourth time (10).

Methods & Sources

Deforestation and fire alerts data are the starting point of the analysis for each of the case studies. After confirming the clearance of native vegetation through satellite imagery, each of the case is then analysed through the Aidenvironment database crossing data from different sources and datasets as described below. Finally, the data is validated by a local partner and a qualitative analysis of each case is developed making use of publicly available data.

Deforestation & Fire

We processed deforestation alert data from the INPE/Deter program for both biomes, Amazon and Cerrado. An alternative source is the Global Forest Watch (GLAD alerts) and the Mapbiomas Alertas platforms. The fire alerts are checked in the NASA/Firms platform and processed using EO Browser Copernicus Sentinel platform. For each selected case, the deforestation is confirmed through satellite images.

Landownership (SIGEF/SNCI/SNCR) and the Environmental Cadastre self-declaration (CAR)

The landownership data is from the Federal Tenure Land systems SIGEF and SNCI, crossing it with SNCR to identify the ownership. The landownership registration on local notary offices is not checked and might be different than the federal systems. The self-declaration for the Environmental Cadastre (CAR) is checked in the Federal System SICAR, including the Legal Reserves and Permanent Preservation Areas (APP) according to the Brazilian Forest Code. For some states, such as Mato Grosso and Pará, it is possible to check the CAR declarant name through the Environmental State Agencies' CAR platforms. It is important to highlight that CAR is not recognized as official ownership data.

Brazilian Forest Code protected areas

Legal Reserves and Permanent Preservation Areas (APP) are defined by the Brazilian Forest Code as having mandatory conservation status on private properties. The size of Legal Reserves in private properties varies according to the biome [80% Amazonia biome, 35% Cerrado biome inside Legal Amazon, 20% other areas], and Permanent Preservation Areas (APP) are those linked to water and soil conservation areas (close to river bases, wetlands, slopes, and high hills.) The Legal Reserve and APP areas considered in this report are those self-declared within the Cadastro Ambiental Rural (CAR) system – Brazil's environmental registration system. In some cases, the CAR was also used to find information on ownership because even if it is a self-declared document, in some cases it still provides the most recent information on who is operating in a property.

Conservation areas and Indigenous Territories

Conservation Areas data is from the ICMBio, responsible for monitoring and management the Officially recognized Natural Reserves according to the National System of Natural Reserves (SNUC – Sistema Nacional de Unidades de Conservação). The SNUC determines jurisdiction of the area - federal, state or local government, or private owner - and how the natural resources may be used by whom in each of the natural reserves' categories. Indigenous Territories data is from FUNAI, the National Foundation for Indigenous Populations. Indigenous Territories are officially recognized and determine areas where local Indigenous populations have customary rights to access and use the land.

Type of Vegetation and Priority for Biodiversity Conservation

The type of vegetation data is from the IBGE (Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics) and Embrapa, consulted through the INPE website. The classification according the Priority for Biodiversity Conservation is from a study elaborated by the Brazilian Ministry of the Environment updated in 2018.

Methods & Sources

Environmental Embargoes and Fines

Embargoed areas and Environmental fines are checked in the database form IBAMA, the Federal Environment Agency. Embargoes are areas where any kind of activity is suspended or unauthorized by IBAMA oftentimes due to environmental degradation or other crimes such as slavery labor. Properties can be removed from the list of embargoed areas after having addressed the problem. Environmental fines are usually linked to regulation infractions and are addressed to the owner of the property.

Company Group and linked properties

Once the ownership of the property is clearly linked to an individual, we use the SINTEGRA database to check all the registered companies under this individual or group of individuals names. If the ownership is already registered by a company, we also check the corporate structure of the company through open sources websites. Once the ownership, linked companies and corporate structure are defined, we search for other properties registered under the same or similar ownership in the Federal Tenure Land systems SIGEF and SNCI.

Level of certainty of links to soy traders and beef processors

Soy – <u>High</u>: trading relationship between the owner of the property and the trader is confirmed by traders or by the National Supply Company (Conab) trading subsidy programs, or traders have assets (warehouses) within the boundaries of the property; <u>Medium</u>: trading relationship with the corporate group, not necessary with the specified property is confirmed by traders or by Conab's subsidy programs; <u>Low</u>: trader is the main soy exporter in the municipality (Trase platform), or traders have assets (warehouses) within a radius of 50 km from the property.

Cattle - <u>High</u>: animal transportation data (GTA) confirm direct trading relationship between the property and beef processors; <u>Medium</u>: animal transportation data (GTA) confirm indirect trading relationship between the property and beef processors; <u>Low</u>: beef processor is the main meat exporter in the municipality (Trase platform), or beef processors have assets (slaughterhouse) within a radius of 50 km from the property.

Main exporters (municipality), warehouses and slaughterhouses

The data on main soy and beef exporters per municipality is from Trase platform. Warehouses' location is from the SICARM and slaughterhouses' location from the Ministry of Agriculture.

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
